Italy, Veneto.

Fresh pear and almond notes infuse this delicately structured, stylish Pinot Grigio. Dry yet rounded, with a refreshing finish.

Neil Joubert Byter – Chenin Blanc £21.00

South Africa, Paarl.

Very attractive nose with lots of tropical fruits such as pineapple, guava and citrus fruit, carrying on to the crisp, refreshing palate. The fullest flavour aperitif wine on the list. Perfect for a warm day sitting on the terrace.

Carr Taylor - 1066 £25.00

West Field, England

Their most popular easy drinking wine. Crisp light and refreshing. Carr Taylor vineyard is located less than a mile from here and has won numerous international awards.

Featherdrop - Sauvignon Blanc. £27.00

New Zealand, Marlborough

Lively aromas of gooseberry, passionfruit, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalise the palate and provide a refreshing clean finish.

La Font de Miratel - Picpoul. £26.00

France, Languedoc.

Elegant aromas of citrus and stone fruits, the wine is light and fresh on the palate with a distinct mineral note. The crisp yet balanced acidity gives the wine an elegant and refreshing finish

Finca Montepedroso - Verdejo £31.00

Spain, Castilla y León.

A vivid expression of the Verdejo grape, with its characteristic notes of fennel, green apple, cut hay and peach, this wine is also imbued with an extra depth and richness in the mouth



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Château de Sancerre, Joseph Mellot Les Collinettes **£39.50**

France, Sancerre

Classic elegance evolves into a classic grassy vibrancy that develops citrus honeyed hints with age.

Château du Seuil, Graves - Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc. **£45.00**

France. Bordeaux – Graves.

A blend of 60% Semillon and 40% Sauvignon Blanc. Part of the Semillon portion is fermented in new French oak barriques. A wine with great depth in the classic mould of a top Graves

Chablis, Jean-Marc Brocard Vieilles Vignes de Ste Claire - Chardonnay **£46.00**

Chablis, Burgundy France

Old vines give great concentration and verve here, with notes of aniseed, lemon and pink grapefruit with real depth and savour. Floral, apple, peach and smoky notes define this lively white.

Vincent Girardin Auxey-Duresses Blanc - Chardonnay **£63.00**

Auxey-Duresses, Burgundy, France

Fresh and aromatic, with bright citrus fruits and delicate floral characters. There is some richness and texture here as well, but the purity of the fruit is what really stands out.

Puligny-Montrachet, Louis Jodot - Grand Vin de Bourgogne **£83.00**

France

Elegant, refined and very classic, shows the firmness required from a wine of this highly regarded estate.

Light and refreshing 8% abv.

England, Westfield.

Carr Taylor vineyard is located less than a mile from here and has won numerous international awards.

Whispering Angel **£27.00**

France,

Whispering Angel from Chateau d'Esclans is arguably the World's greatest Rosé. The grapes come from the most select land in the surrounding region of La Motte in Provence. This dry rosé is crisp, fresh and elegant and comes highly recommended.

Vicount della Rocca- Primitivo - 2017 <i>Italy, Puglia</i> Intense, fruity Primitivo full of jammy plum fruit and savoury spice. Smooth-textured with a lick of vanilla on the finish.	£22.00
Prunus, Dão Tinto <i>Dão, Portugal.</i> Lightly oaked and perfectly balanced, with a silky texture and crisp edge. The nose is cram-packed with mulberries, blackberries and anise. On the palate black cherry and raspberry fruit tones with creamy and chocolaty oak flavours.	£24.00
Swooper Pinot Noir 2017 <i>South Eastern Australia</i> Juicy and full flavoured Pinot with cherry and blueberry aromas	£24.00
Deakin Estate, Shiraz - 2017 <i>Victoria, Australia</i> Good punchy Shiraz aromas of mulberry and plum, supported by hints of vanilla and coffee oak. The palate is juicy, spicy and satisfying, with a rounded finish.	£27.00
Château Mayne Vieux - Merlot/Cabernet Franc. 2014 Castillon – Cotes de Bordeaux, France Estate bottled by a small, family-run domaine close to St Emilion since 1950. The nose is a pleasant bouquet of ripe red fruits, with undergrowth and grilled notes. After a subtle attack, the mouth gains in volume and roundness, showing fine tannins.	£28.00
Decero, Malbec - 2016 <i>Argentina, Mendoza.</i> Intense violet aromas and purity of raspberry and red fruit flavours, with a kick of white pepper, a very assured, sleek texture, and a long, energetic finish.	£32.00



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Finca Valpiedra. Rioja Reserva. 2012	£43.00
<i>Spain, Rioja</i>	
Perfect balance between ripe black fruits and aromas that come from the oak ageing such as vanilla and toffee. The palate is very smooth with an aftertaste balsamic and fruity notes.	
Rasteau, Domaine de Beurenard. 2016	£49.50
<i>France, Rhone, Châteauneuf du Pape</i>	
80% Grenache, 20% Syrah. This highly concentrated wine, made from vines planted on the best slopes and terraces of the famous Rasteau soils, has an appealingly strong personality. Besides aromas of very ripe fruit, it is generally laced with notes of spice and garrigue scrubland scents specific to this terroir. Appealing tannic structure, a rounded body, rich and powerful...this is the Beurenard's typically strong character.	
Lédé de Labégorce - Margaux. 2012	£59.00
<i>France, Bordeaux, Margaux</i>	
An elegant wine from a property owned by Henri Lurton, who is also the proprietor of second-gro with Château Brane-Cantenac. This vineyard with 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc, is typical of the Médoc; the wine is fermented in stainless steel and aged in French oak (20% new) for about a year. A rich, well-structured wine.	
Château Saint-Estephe. 2008	£69.50
<i>France, Bordeaux St Estephe</i>	
This is a wonderful example of traditional Saint-Estèphe, with earthy, blackberry and dried herb aromas, a concentrated but still medium-bodied palate, and a moreish finish
